THE TENEBRAE

The Tenebrae, meaning "shadows", is one of the oldest Holy Week rituals in Christendom. As the Passion story unfolds the darkness increases. With the death of our Lord, only one light is left burning: the light of God's love. For a time this light is carried out of the room, symbolizing Christ's three days in the tomb. but, like god's love, this light is never extinguished.

A loud noise symbolizes Christ's victory over death and the stone rolling away from the tomb. The candle is then returned to the altar in anticipation of Easter Day and our Lord's joyous resurrection from the dead.

OPENING EXCHANGE
